<p>*clothing: Avoid Cotton! wool or poly best *rain gear/shell/jacket/fleece Footwear: boots, sneakers</p> <p>*water bottle, water (2liter/day+) *trail food</p> <p>*knife/multi-tool *matches & fire starting kit *first aid kit *flashlight/headlamp & extra batteries rope/cord *map/compass, Trail Guide? *sunglasses, sunscreen, hat Whistle, signal mirror</p> <p>sleeping bag, sleeping mat, pillow? tent, groundcloth, extra stakes? personal cup, plate?, utensils Food (your contribution) Tarp/Emergency Blanket</p> <p>toothbrush/toothpaste, towel, soap</p>	<p><u>Warm weather:</u> insect repellent bathing suit?</p> <p><u>Winter:</u> long underwear hat, gloves/mittens, balaclava? wool socks hand/feet warmers Gaiters / Snowshoes? / Cleats?</p> <p><u>Other Optional (depending on trip):</u> Day pack water filter/purification? Lantern shovel/pick toilet paper?, shovel? Flip flops (for showers) Camping chairs Hiking stick/poles</p>
